A – Drop of effort to heal the poverty, with this caption this association was started in Dec 2007, a non – profit association formed by student community of our college. An idea was to motivate the student to come together to help the poverty people. Since 2007 till now we **29,89,500** for this association.

It envisioned to create a public awareness and involvement to care of our poor students, orphans & disabled.

The students contribute 1 Rs / Week to this association, since 2007 till now this association donated to the needy people in around the salem society.

Objectives of Siruthuli Association :

1. Considering “Helping Profession” as a major social work
2. Donating the needy students for their education

From 2007 – 2012

The students contributed **3,51,000** to the CSI girls boarding home, idaya sudar orphanage, kamalayam orphanage, masinaikanpatti orphanage, mentally retarded children & physically challenged – artificial legs was donated, orphan disabled female child.

2013 – 2014

The Siruthuli donate **51,000** to the poor students of AVSCAS for their education 46,500 amount contributed to orphanages for kalaiyarasi a cancer patient Rs. 10,000 was donated.

2014 – 2015

This year the Siruthuli contributed 84,000 to orphanage & poor students of AVSCAS students **50,000** donated for the child sujan for his open heart surgery, 30,000 amount sponsored for AVSCAS poor students.

2015 – 2016

55,000 donated to Ragavendra orphanage Amudha surabhi charitable trust, Nirali girl child affected with thalasimia disease and done 12,00,000 for her treatment.

2016 – 2017

1,40,000 amount contributed to orphanage & 40,000 amount was sponsored for the economically backward students to continue their education @ AVSCAS.

In 2015, cuddalore was affected with heavy rainfall & lashed cuddalore, more than 1000 people lost their homes people suffered lot for their basic necessities mass of AVSCAS students went around salem, namakkal, krishnagiri & dharmapuri districts & collected the food materials, medicines & other basic items of worth **10,00,000** & cash worth of Rs. **54,00,000** was donated to the flood affected people.

2017 – 2018

Siruthuli donated Rs **6,00,000** to prabavathi girl studying her 11th standard for her kidney transplantation treatment on the mark of education development day government Hr. Sec. School students were issued with note book & stationeries 1000 school students was benefitted in this day Rs. **77,000** worth materials was donated to orphanage, such as care mercy orphanage, karunai illam, vidivelli orphanage, karunya mentally challenges, maduram orphanage, thai anbu illam.



2018 – 2019

In this year the heavy rainfall hit the total kerala state more than 20 districts was affected, 2000 people lost their homes, AVSCAS students collected 50,000 from the publics & donated to kerala chief minister for their flood reform activities. Siruthuli club donate 50,000 for the materials such as garments, bed sheets, pillows & sent to kerala people.

On the mark of Kamarajar birthday 1000 govt school students was issued with note books & stationeries

Rs. 80,000 was donate to orphanage such as Niraivalvu maiyam, Anbu illam, St Mary's, Blind school, little hearts mentally challenged orphanage

2019 – 2020

1117 govt school students benefited with note books & stationary on the mark of Kamarajar Birthday. 50,000 Worth material was donated to orphanages.
